attended “2014 Ombudsman Global Conference”, “AOA Board of  
Directors Meeting” and “IOI Asia Region General Meeting”  
from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2014 in Seoul, Korea.**

In commemoration of the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Ombudsman of Korea, promoting achievement of Korea’s Ombudsman institution and search for future direction for further development, the Anti-Corruption and Civil Rights Commission (ACRC) hosted “2014 Ombudsman Global Conference” from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2014 in Seoul, Korea. The ACRC among others, also invited Mr. Abdur Rauf Chaudhry, Federal Tax Ombudsman, who attended the Conference. The Conference was attended by the Head of Ombudsman Institutions from 12 countries and more than 200 domestic as well as international participants.

During two days sessions, the participants shared successful experiences and examples of their own ombudsman system and came up with ideas to boost global level cooperation in this regard. On behalf of Mr. Salman Faruqi, Federal Ombudsman, Mr. Abdur Rauf Chaudhry, Federal Tax Ombudsman presented a paper on “30 Years of Institution of Ombudsman in Pakistan and the Reforms of 2013” in the Conference.



Besides the above Conference, the Anti-Corruption and Civil Rights Commission also hosted the Board of Directors of the Asian Ombudsman Association (AOA)’s meeting and International Ombudsman Institute (IOI) Asian Region General meeting on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2014 in Seoul. The AOA Board meeting was attended by the participants from 12 countries in Asia, Europe and North America, including Chairman, ACRC, AOA Treasurer and IOI Board Members wherein Gangwon Province Ombudsman’s membership application was approved.
