

Subject: Transit Permission to Afghanistan

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the Collectorates shall process and decide the cases of transit of non commercial cargo to Afghanistan as per Pak-Afghan Transit Trade Agreement, 1965 by ensuring transportation across the border with no misuse of the facility and subject to the condition that transportation should take place through Pak. Railways or NLC trucks, the vehicles, if any in transit, are "Left Hand Drive" and Embassy of Afghanistan/Government of Afghanistan certifies that goods/consignments are bonafide transit goods.
